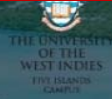

BIO ON FEATURED SPEAKER



Professor C. Justin Robinson is a national of St. Vincent and the Grenadines. A proud UWI Alumnus with a BSc in Management Studies (First Class Honours) from the Cave Hill Campus, he has an MSc in Finance and Econometrics from Florida International University and obtained his PhD in Finance from the University of Manchester, UK.

In more than 20 years with The UWI, Professor Robinson has served as Head of the Department of Management Studies, Cave Hill Campus; Executive Director of Sagicor Cave Hill School of Business & Management; Dean of the Faculty of Social Sciences; and Pro Vice-Chancellor of the Board for Undergraduate Studies. He was also a member of the working group that established the Five Islands Campus in 2018.

He is a Professor of Corporate Finance, and his research interests are in Capital Markets in Developing Countries, Public Finance, Financial Risk Management, and Corporate Finance. He has published over 50 refereed publications in several regional and international journals.

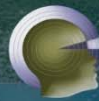
Before he was appointed Campus Principal at The UWI Five Islands, Professor Robinson was leading the implementation of the Policy to support the Multi-Campus Teaching & Learning Initiative, overseeing the conduct of a two-year pilot from 2022 to 2024. This initiative facilitates the sharing of teaching resources across the five UWI campuses to expose students to the full range of UWI expertise and allow for economies of scale in the deployment of teaching resources.

In addition, he oversaw the implementation of The UWI Foreign Language Policy, which requires students entering The UWI from the academic year 2022/2023 to demonstrate competence in a language other than English before graduation.

Professor Robinson is actively engaged in public service and serves as a Director of the Central Bank of Barbados, a Member of the Fiscal Responsibility Mechanism, St. Vincent and the Grenadines, a Director of Jamaica Money Market Brokers International, and a Director of West India Biscuit Company. He also serves as Chair of the Ratings Committee of CARICRIS (the Caribbean's sole credit rating agency) and First Vice President of the Barbados Museum and Historical Society. He has been a Director of the Central Bank of Barbados since 2008 and a financial adviser to the Barbados Credit Union League since 2009.

He is the third Principal of Five Islands Campus, appointed on August 1, 2023.

BIO ON DISTINGUISHED LECTURER AND GUEST OF HONOUR



Andrea N. Baldwin is an Associate Professor in the Divisions of Gender and Ethnic Studies and serves as the Associate Dean for Research in the School for Cultural and Social Transformation at the University of Utah. An attorney-at-law, she holds a master's degree in international trade policy and a Ph.D. in gender and development studies from the Institute for Gender and Development Studies, Nita Barrow Unit, UWI Cave Hill.

Dr. Baldwin is the founder of the Black Feminist Eco Lab at the University of Utah and the creator and co-host of *Standpoints*, a Black feminist podcast produced by Virginia Tech Publishing. Her scholarly work includes a 2021 book monograph, several co-edited volumes, and journal articles in *Frontiers*, *Wagadu*, *Peitho*, *the International Journal of Africana Studies*, *The Body Studies Journal*, *the Journal of International Women Studies*, and *Theoretical Practice*.

Before joining the University of Utah, Dr. Baldwin worked with Invest Barbados, the Delegation of the European Union to Barbados and the Eastern Caribbean States, and Virginia Tech.

Born and raised in Barbados, she proudly identifies as an all-around Caribbean woman with a deep love of Soca music.

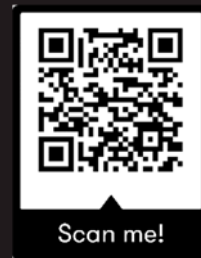
